Entry Level Police Officer

Applicant Requirements:

- 20 years of age
- United States Citizen
- Valid Driver's License
- Physically and mentally fit
- High School Diploma or GED
- Applicants must possess a minimum of 30 college credits from an accredited institution of higher education or consideration may be given for one of the following waivers during the selection process:
 - Applicants with at least 3 years of active military duty and an Honorable Discharge will be granted a full waiver of the college credits
 - Applicants with current certification as a police officer (Act 120 or equivalent) and at least 2 years of full-time experience will be granted a full waiver of the college credits

Application Submission and Due Dates:

- **Application may be submitted:**
 - Online via the Online Test Registration Form no later than **4:30pm on September 17, 2024.**
 - By hand/in person to the Quakertown Borough Police Department no later than **4:30pm on September 17, 2024.**
 - By mail and post marked on or before **September 17, 2024.**
- There are no extensions or exceptions for the required submission dates.
- There is no application fee to take the exam.



Written Test Information:

- Candidates must be able to attend 1 of the following in-person written examination dates:
 - Tuesday, September 24, 2024 - 6:30pm registration, 7:00pm exam start
 - Thursday, September 26, 2024 - 6:30pm registration, 7:00pm exam start
 - Saturday, September 28, 2024 - 9:00am registration, 9:30am exam start
- Examination locations will be based on the number of applicants. Applicants will receive an email notification of their testing location at least 1 week prior to the written exam.
- A valid driver's license photo id is required at the time of check-in to the written examination.
- A minimum score of 70% is required to pass the written examination.
- Results will be emailed out to all applicants.

Physical Agility Test:

- All applicants with a passing grade on the written exam will be invited to participate in the Physical Agility testing.
 - Saturday, October 12, 2024 – Candidates will be notified of their testing time, Faith Christian Academy High School (2255 Allentown Road, Quakertown, PA 18951)
- The requirements for the physical agility testing are attached to this packet.
- Physical agility testing is scored on a PASS/FAIL basis.
- Results will be emailed out to all applicants.

Oral Examination:

- Applicants that successfully pass the physical agility test may be invited to attend an oral examination that will be scheduled.
- Applicants will be contacted to schedule their oral examination. All oral examinations take place at Quakertown Borough Police Station, 35 N. Third Street, Quakertown, PA 18951.

Background Investigations:

- Applicants who successfully pass the written, physical, and oral examination will be eligible for a background investigation that includes a polygraph examination.
