



## Important Information regarding COVID-19

Perkiomen Tours has always taken the safety and welfare of our travelers very seriously. Our commitment to motorcoach cleanliness is a hallmark of our company and often commented on by our travelers. Many years ago, we added to our daily motorcoach cleaning process the use of a very effective disinfectant and the results have been quite successful. In response to the recent occurrence of COVID-19, we have added even more steps to our cleaning process to further protect our travelers and employees.

- We continue to thoroughly clean each motorcoach when it returns from a trip. Every vehicle begins the next assignment having been cleaned and disinfected.
- In addition to routine cleaning, our process now includes mopping the floor and wiping all high-contact areas\* with an additional disinfecting cleaning solution. This solution is commonly used in hospitals and schools as it has proven to be very effective against several viruses including COVID-19.
- After the initial cleaning and subsequent disinfection, an additional step of sanitizing the motorcoach cabin is performed using a non-toxic, safe, and ecofriendly hydrogen peroxide-based solution. According to the CDC, hydrogen peroxide is effective in deactivating viruses including rhinovirus, the virus that causes the common cold, within minutes of exposure. Rhinovirus is more difficult to destroy than coronaviruses. The driver will also reapply this disinfecting solution to high-contact areas\* throughout each trip.
- HVAC filters are now cleaned and disinfected as part of our mechanic's pre-trip inspection process. If there is any question about a filter's condition or effectiveness it is replaced.
- The HVAC system ducting is disinfected using a fogger prior to each motorcoach leaving our maintenance facility for use on a trip.

\*High-contact areas include handrails, arm rests, seatbelt buckles, windowsills, lavatory door handle, lavatory, and parcel rack doors.

**Perkiomen is also taking measures to protect the health and welfare of our drivers. It is important that you follow all instructions, whether written or spoken, when traveling with us and cooperatively accept all necessary enforcement of the rules by our driver.**

### What is required of our driver?

1. The driver's temperature will be taken and recorded prior to departing our terminal. If his/her temperature is 100.4 Fahrenheit or greater, he/she will not be permitted to drive, and a replacement driver will be arranged as quickly as possible.
2. The driver will wear a facemask while performing all duties including driving the motorcoach.
3. The driver will wash his/her hands or use hand sanitizer frequently throughout the trip.
4. The driver will limit his/her exposure to sickness by being cautious and sensible throughout the trip.
5. The driver is not permitted to be in close physical contact with passengers including hand shaking and the like. If necessary, the driver will provide basic assistance to passengers requiring it to board or disembark the motorcoach.
6. Throughout the trip, the driver will disinfect high-contact areas when the motorcoach is not occupied.

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
