§ 302 Intent.
 [Ord. 946, 2/13/1989, § 1; as amended by Ord. 1004, 7/6/1994]

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any container to stand or be parked on any public street, sidewalk, alley or public parking lot unless a proper permit has been secured and the appropriate fee has been paid.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any container to stand or be parked on any public street, sidewalk, alley or public parking lot unless proper operable, warning, blinking lights are provided/attached at both the front and rear of the container closest to the street side of the container.

§ 303 Permit and Fees.
 [Ord. 946, 2/13/1989, § 1; as amended by Ord. 1004, 7/6/1994]

1. Any person wishing to obtain a permit for placement of any refuse container, dumpster, or construction trailer must apply in writing with the Borough Code Office giving the name, address, and phone number of a responsible individual; the name, address and phone number of the owner of the container; and, the name, address and phone number of the property that requires use of the container. The permit application will also contain a statement relieving the Borough of any civil liability due to any damage caused by the applicant's placement of such a container. The applicant will also be responsible for the upkeep of the warning devices placed on or around the container.
2. A permit issued will be good for 30 days. If an applicant requires more than 30 days. At no time will a container be permitted for more than 90 days.
3. **Permit Fee is \$50 for 30 Days. Each additional 30 days is another \$50.** Maximum of 90 Days

§ 304 Penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not less than \$25 and not exceeding \$600 plus costs and, in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days.
