

A special meeting of the Borough Council was held November 26, 2012, 7:30 p.m.

The following members and officers were present: President L. James Roberts, Vice President Donald Rosenberger, Councilmembers David Erwin, Michael Johnson, Douglas Propst, Edward Scholl and Daniel Williams, Solicitor Charles Fonzone and Manager Scott C. McElree.

President Roberts stated that tonight's meeting was advertised for the purpose of considering obtaining state funds for the Streetscape Program.

President Roberts explained that a year ago, Council applied for funds from the state in the amount of \$173,423. However, Council wishes to ask for additional funds and, therefore, another public hearing must be held to reapply for a new amount.

Councilman Scholl asked what this phase will accomplish? Manager McElree stated that it will complete the street lights and provide crosswalks.

RESOLVED, That, the following Resolution 105-12, funding for Quakertown Alive! Streetscape Program, be adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 105-12

WHEREAS, the Borough of Quakertown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$249,245 for the Quakertown Alive! Streetscape Program.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Quakertown to file this resolution with the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development to apply for a total funding of \$249,245; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough of Quakertown and Quakertown Alive! will assume the provision of the full, local share of project costs, and they will reimburse the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the State's share of any expenditures found by the Department to be ineligible.

Motion of Councilman Scholl, seconded by Councilman Rosenberger. **A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN AND THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.**

President Roberts adjourned the special meeting at 7:36 p.m.
